
How to replace button packs on the Vista III/IV: Standard housing -- front view

parts layout and identifiers

- (2) 0K00-1957-00 side-button packs [four buttons]
- (1) 0K00-1958-xx legend-button pack [seven buttons]
 - 0K00-1958-00 = button colors: Red, Blue, Green
 - 0K00-1958-01 = button colors: Green, Blue, Green
- (2) 0F85-2406-00 plastic spacer inserts



tools list and identifiers

- (1) towel or similar protection for front screen
- (1) #2 Phillips head screwdriver
- (1) 5/32" hex socket/drive or nut driver for corner posts

(4) corner posts [typical, if used]

• tool: 5/32" hex socket/drive or nut driver



Series 6231 -- Vista III

(4 or 8) perimeter screws [typical]

• tool: #2 Phillips-head screwdriver



Series 6241 -- Vista IV


How to replace button packs on Vista III /IV:

- 1. Place the Vista display face down on a clean towel, to prevent scratching.
- 2. Remove (4) anchor posts at back corners (if used).
- 3. Remove (4 or 8) screws around back perimeter.


The plastic housing for the Vista will now be in two separable pieces -- front and rear.

NOTE: The rear housing is different between the Vista III and the Vista IV:

- On the Vista III it is possible to entirely remove the rear housing from the rest of the Vista assembly.
- On the Vista IV there is a circuit board attached to the rear housing. Ribbon cables connect the rear circuit board to the front, which limits the movement of the rear housing.
- 4. Gently tilt up to a the back housing at as shown. DO NOT PUT TENSION ON THE RIBBON CABLES.



5. Remove the old button packs as needed.



- 6. Replace with new button packs. Check that centering is Ok.
- 7. Replace the back plastic housing.
- 8. Replace the perimeter screws and the corner posts (if used). Do not over-torque the screw threads.
